NOTES OF THE MONTH.

NOVEMBER is from the Latin word *Novem*, nine, which indicated its position in the days of Romulus. The Saxons styled it wind-monat or wind month, and blot-monat or blood month, because at this time they were in the habit of killing oxen, sheep and pigs, for salting for the winter. *Sagittarius*, the Archer, is the sign which the sun enters on the 22d. The 1st is All Saints' Day, in honor of the Roman Pantheon being, in 607, converted into a Christian Church. The 5th is the now almost obsolete Guy Fawkes' Day, a memorial of the Gunpowder Plot. The 9th is Lord Mayor's Day, and the birthday of the Prince of Wales. On this day the chief magistrate of London is sworn in at Westminster. The 11th is St. Martin's, and the 30th St. Andrew's Day.
