CRIME:

Rex vs. Joe Edward, Manslaughter. Acquitted
Rex vs. Paul B. Paul, Murder. Charge reduced to
Manslaughter. Convicted and sentenced to five
years imprisonment in the Penitentiary.
Rex Vs. William Allen, Manslaughter Acquitted.

The Indian Agent and Constable S.K. Bruce attended the Spring Assizes on the 26th, 27, 28, 29 and 30th in the interest of two Indians of the Agency, Joe Edwards and Paul B. Paul, charged with manslaughter and murder respectively. As above stated, Joe Edward was acquitted and Paul sentended to 5 years in the Penitentiary. A third Indian William Allen stood trial for manslaughter at the Vernon Assizes, and was acquitted.
