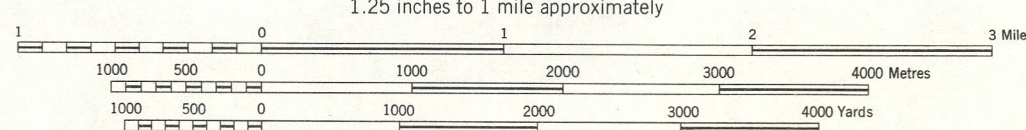


MAGNETIC DECLINATION 12°00' WEST
