A Great Ontario Agony Over—Smith Defeats Sangster.

OTTAWA, Aug. 21.
The voting at Toronto for representatives in the Council of Public Instruction is concluded. For Teachers' representative Goldwin Smith is elected, receiving 1,612 votes to Sangster's 1,335. Professor Wilson is elected to represent the High School teachers. Mr. Wood is elected representative of the School Inspectors, beating David Mills, M. P., by a vote of 30 to 17. Sangster would not have received such a large vote but for the persuasion of the Globe.
