THE Table exhibiteth the PLANETS Places in the Celestial Signs of the Zodiac at Noon, the first feventh, thirteenth, nineteenth and twenty fifth Days of each Month in the Year, &c. The first Column towards the left Hand contains the Days of the Months, the fecond the Names of the Months, the third the Sun's Place, as against January the 1st, stands 11 by 41, which denotes that the Sun will be 11 Degrees and 41 Mututes in the Sign called Capricorn, &c. The fourth Column contains Saturn's Place, and against January the 1st, under 5 and 32 stands 14, which denotes that 5, that is Saturn, will be 14 Degrees in 32, that is Virgo; and fo on for the reft. Learn the Characters of the Signs and Planets, if you defire to understand the Ephemeries, which Characters are as follow.

An EXPLANATION of the CALENDAR PAGES.

A FTER the Chronological Table of remarkable Events, which is continued at the Head of each Page in fucceffion, then follows the Time of the Moon's Fulling, Changing & Quartering in each Month. The fucceeding Columns are diffinguished by the Letters, Marks and Words at the Top of each. 1. M fignifies Month, and flows the Day of the Month. 2. W denotes Week, and flows the Day of the Week. 3. Noted Days, Weather, &c. 4. $r. \odot s$. Rifing and Setting of the Sun. Note, the Middle Row of Figures in this Column are the Minutes of rifing after the Hour, and of fetting before it. 15. D's place, The Sign or place of the Moon. 6. $r. \odot s$. The rifing and fetting of the Moon. 7. Full Sea, or Time of High Water at Halifax.
