not exceeding Three Pound Ten Shillings per diem to each Commissioner while employed in the performance of his duties. nor One Thousand Pounds per annum, to any Commissioner: And of Secre- and the said Secretaries shall be remunerated for their services at such rate not exceeding Seven Hundred and Fifty Pounds 5 per annum, as the Governor in Council shall determine, but the said Secretaries shall give their whole time to the duties of their office.

Place of Meeting, &c.

XVII. The Commissioners shall hold their meetings at such place as shall be appointed by the Governor, and the Secretaries 10 shall keep minutes of the proceedings at such meetings.

Payment of &c.

XVIII. The remuneration to the Commissioners and Secretaremuneration, ries, with such expenses as may be incurred by them for travelling expenses, printing, stationery and other things necessary to the due performance of their duties under this Act, shall be 15 paid by warrant of the Governor, out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, as shall also the rent of their place of meeting. if such place be not in any Public Building.

Accounting clause.

XIX. All moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for to Her Majesty, and to the Legislature in the man-20 ner provided by Law.
