An Act to separate the Township of Delaware from the West Riding of the County of Middlesex, and to annex the same to the East Riding thereof.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Township of Delaware have Preamble:
prayed that the said township may be separated from the West
Riding of the county of Middlesex, and annexed to the East Riding of
the same county, for electoral and agricultural purposes, as it is now
for municipal and judicial purposes, and for the registration of deeds,
and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore
Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 1. Upon and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hun-pelaware and dred and sixty-four, the said township of Delaware shall be separated next to the from the West Riding of the county of Middlesex, and annexed to and for all purshall form part of the East Riding of the same county, for electoral, poses, agricultural, and all other purposes whatsoever.
  - 2. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
