Dear Sirs,

I have a letter from Mr. W. J. Kraemer
of Dauphin, Manitoba, an engineer in the employ of the
C.N.R.

Mr. Kraemer advises that he bought lots
1 and 2 of Block 26, Kamsack, in 1912 from the C.N.R. town-
site authorities. These were paid for and in 1913 he re-
quested title and was advised to send in his contract which
was No.19336, and that title would be forwarded forthwith.
This was done by him, but since he has never been able to
secure the title, and as late as 1917 (five years later)
he states that he took the matter up with your Department
and was advised that there was nothing on record in the
Department of Indian Affairs, nor had there been any money
received on this property.

Will you please advise your record of
this matter and greatly oblige.
