Referring to letter addressed you on the 10th of October, 1914, and prior correspondence, in connection with right of way of the Grand Trunk Pacific Branch Lines through the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 12, Tp. 20, Rge. 15, W. 2nd, Pasqua reserve, I beg to say that it was in error stated that Letters Patent had been issued for this land, as the patent to which reference was made, covered only land outside of the reserve.

There is due by the Company on account of the land acquired on this quarter section the sum of \$48.18 principal and \$29.52 interest, making in all the sum of \$77.70, upon receipt of cheque for which letters patent will be issued to the Company.
