In order to enable us to make units employed on the Atlantic Coast available for the defence of the West Coast in the event of an emergency, it has been necessary to recommend the provision of aerodromes on Vancouver Island. For two aerodromes on Vancouver Island and the partial development thereof, an amount of \$100,000.00 has been included.

\$50,000.00 has been allowed for the purchase and development of a site for a seaplane station at Prince Rupert, as the base for the Flying Boat Squadron which will be responsible for covering Queen Charlotte Islands and the mainland adjacent thereto.

\$35,000.00 has been included for the Air Force share of the development of an inland Magazine for the West Coast, the balance of which is the responsibility of the Army.

In addition to the foregoing, minor works have been included:-

At Ottawa, amounting to a total of --- \$37,500.00 at Calgary " " " \$10,000.00 at Petawawa " " " \$19.250.00

The total for Engineer Services therefore amounts to \$1,769,300.00 for land and development, and for new construction.
