Ottawa, October 22, 1908.

Gentlemen,-

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th instant, inclosing memo. of dues payable on timber cut on the Doncaster Reserve limit last season, and specification of measurements, and affidavits made to quantities of spruce and cedar cut thereon.

In reply I have to inform you that the specification of spruce logs, 13 feet, shows the contents of 542 pieces of 6 inches in diameter as 4878 feet B.M., instead of 2168 feet, and the contents of 1759 pieces of 7 inches in diameter as 19,349 feet B.M., instead of 14,072 feet, making a total reduction of 7987 feet. This quantity at 80 cents per M. feet amounts to \$6.39, which sum you may deduct from your statement, leaving \$953.65 payable to the Department.
