Ottawa, 4th. March, 1910.

Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 26th ultimo No.

20 A. respecting the location of the bull stable, I beg
to say that the suggestion to cut off section 7 from the
Saulteau Indians'Reserve, and reserve it for Agency bulls
and give them the equivalent in the vicinity of Stinking
Lake; is not approved and cannot be acted upon.

There would however appear to be no objection to erecting the bull stable on section 7 adjoining Moos-omins Reserve. This Department is not prepared to ask the Department of Interior to set aside any further lands in consequence of the erection of a bull stable.
