Sir,-

Referring to your letter of March 11, last, and previous correspondence in which you report that judgments secured against persons in your district for drunkenness and other disorders are in many cases quashed by the Court at Beaulieu; I have to say that this matter has been brought to the attention of the Department of Justice here with a view to having a remedy for this condition of affairs provided.

In reply a request has been made by the Deputy Minister of Justice for a list of the cases in which it is conceived that the judgment was improperly quashed, with the particulars in each case. I have, therefore, to request that you will furnish at an early date as possible, the information asked for, in order that this matter may be at once dealt with.
