I beg to inform you that you are hereby appointed Medical Officer for the Sechelt Boarding School. You will not be placed on salary in connection with your services to the school, but, it is desired that you will visit the Institution upon being notified by the Management that your services are required in return for which a payment of \$25.00 will be made to you which will cover all services and expenses. It must be distinctly understood that before you leave Vancouver you shall make arrangements with another physician to attend, should necessity arise, Indian Patients who otherwise would have received your services.
