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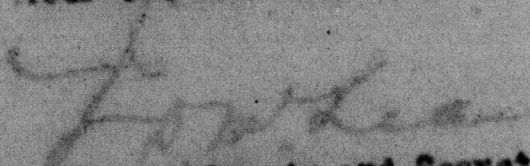
Ottawa, March 24, 1914.

Sir,

I beg to refer to your letter of Nov. 18, 1913, your file 503, and to request that the Royal Commission will be good enough to deal with the Mission Reserve No. 1 Burrard Inlet, of the Squamish Indians at as early a date as possible.

In this connection, I beg to state for the information of the Commission that the Yorkshire Guarantee and Securities Corporation has made a valuation amounting approximately to \$171942.50 of the frontage referred to in your said letter and previous correspondence, in the said Mission Indian Reserve, required by the Department of Public Works for the purposes of a wharf.
