Ottawa, 15th February 1918.

Sir,-

Referring to your communication of the 11th instant I have to request you to report in full on the resolution of the Walpole Indian Council to the effect that the contractors for building bridges across the dredge cut be notified in writing to get the materials for building the said bridges out before the next regular meeting of the Council and if they fail to do so that their contract should be cancelled.

Please report who are the contractors and which bridges are referred to. In accordance with your recommendation \$200.00 was paid to Johnson Peters on account of his contract to build two bridges across the dredge cut. We have received no communication from you regarding the contract to Joseph Nahdee to build the other two bridges across the dredge cut.

The said resolution of the Indian Council will not be approved until the full report requested has been received from you; you should however inform the contractors of the resolution passed by the Council.
