The accused, No. A19419, Sapper Lorne Long, and No. A19425, and Sapper Maurice Francis Flynn, both of the 7th Canadian Field Company, R.C.E., both members of the Canadian Army (Active), are, charged with:

FIRST CHARGE

A.A. Sec. 48⁸⁴²

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE

the said Sapper Long, using violence to his superior officer, and the said Sapper Flynn, an accessory before the fact to the same offence,

in that the said Sapper Long near Guillemont Barracks, Cove, Hants., on 25 Feb 41, at or about 2200 hrs, when ordered by A19315, L/Cpl. J.J. Holland, 7th Canadian Field Company, R.C.E., his superior officer, to come to the said Lance-Corporal, fired a service rifle at the said L/Cpl., and when the said L/Cpl. attempted to apprehend him, fired four more shots at the said L/Cpl.

in that the said Sapper Flynn, shortly before the time and date aforesaid

at Guillemont Barracks, Cove, Hants, did incite counsel and procure the said Sapper Long to commit the said offence.

SECOND CHARGE (Alternative)
A.A. Sec. 41

COMMITTING A CIVIL OFFENCE, that is to say

the said Sapper Long, shooting at a person with intent, contrary to Sec. 18 of the Offences Against the Person Act, 1861; the said Sapper Flynn an accessory before the fact to the same offence,

in that the said Sapper Long

did shoot at L/Cpl. J.J. Holland, 7 Cdn FA Coy RCE, with intent to resist the lawful apprehension of the said accused.

in that the said Sapper Flynn did incite, counsel and procure the said Sapper Long to commit the said offence.
