Entrance fee for Farmers' Race, 5 per cent of Purse—must be owned by a farmer who is actively engaged in farming—open to horses that never started for money before. Judges decision in all cases to be final. All entries to be made with the Secretary of Race Committee before 12 noon on day of Race. Competitors confined to one race only in these contests. THOS.
