SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, excepting 2 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or eldest over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less.
