





Bookkeeping in any business is an expensive proposition. Any system which will make bookkeeping easier and avoid mistakes is of great value. Many Account Registers of various styles have been placed on the market, they have proven very valuable in saving time and avoiding mistakes. It was found however that in order to be of real value, any account register must be kept in a fireproof cabinet

At present the market is flooded with so-called "fireproof" cabinets containing Account Registers. The walls of most of these cabinets are so thin, they cannot possibly resist an ordinary fire. Some of them have glass covers which are easily broken. Some have different compartments requiring transfer of accounts from one compartment to the other, all of which

The "Canton" Register has recently been placed on the market which overcomes most of these difficulties. It consists of a strong, well-made metal cabinet. The walls are made of special heat-resisting material, and are double, with one inch air space between; this gives much better fire protection. It contains receptacles in which may be filed account slips or in which a separate book may be kept for each customer. No index is required and only one writing is necessary. These cabinets are made in different sizes. For instance: our one hundred account cabinet contains space for one hundred steady customers, also for an equal number of transient or occasional customers. This cabinet occupies a counter space of 13½ by 20 inches and is 24 inches high. They are built in six sizes at following prices delivered to your store:

To give an idea of the substantial construction of these registers we might state that our 200 Account Register weighs about 265 lbs. Yhis Register was patented November 21st. 1916, and is the last word in fireproof cabinet construction.
