WHEREAS at a meeting of the St. John's Municipal Council, held December 19th, 1902, certain Rules and Regulations were adopted, providing a basis whereby a charge could be fixed for the supplying of water to sailing vessels, steamers, tugs, launches, etc., and for extra water:
