Firpo Takes the Count in the Second Round—Manchester-London Air Mail Plane Crash Causes 5 Deaths—Graeco-Italian Situation Considered Regulated.

RIVERA ASKED TO FORM MINISTRY.

MADRID, Sept. 14. King Alfonso this afternoon asked Captain General Primo Rivera, the leader of the military movement against Albuca's Cabinet, to form a Government. It was announced by Captain General Muniz Cobo, of Madrid, who is charged with the maintenance of public order, that a proclamation of martial law was necessary.

DIRECTORATE ACCEPTED.

BARCELONA, Sept. 14. Captain General Primo Rivera, whom King Alfonso has charged with the forming of a new Government, declared this afternoon that the King, with whom he conversed by telephone, has accepted the directorate proposed by the military chiefs.

MARTIAL LAW IN MADRID.

MADRID, Sept. 14. Martial law has been proclaimed, and the streets of Madrid are patrolled by military. Primo Rivera, leader of the revolution, who has been asked by the King to form a new ministry, has instructed the military judges to institute proceedings against Santiago Alba, former Foreign Minister, and has issued a proclamation inviting all Spaniards to declare themselves on the political morality of the former minister who is believed to be a refugee in Biarritz.

MEXICO'S EXCUSE.

MEXICO CITY, Sept. 14. Mexico has declined the invitation from Latin American delegates to the League of Nations to become a member of the League. The fact that diplomatic relations between Mexico and Great Britain have not yet been resumed and that Great Britain has a delegate in the League Council is deemed to be the obstacle preventing Mexico from making application for admission to the League.

NO TRAGIC CONSEQUENCES ANTICIPATED.

PARIS, Sept. 14. French official opinion is that a solution of the Spanish crisis will probably be arranged in Madrid without tragic consequences. The attitude of the French Government is one of absolute detachment, except that events are being followed with friendly interest and hopes for Spain's welfare.
