Toronto, Sept. 17.—Wheat—The offerings are more liberal since the decline in prices in the west, and the market is easier, at 84c to 85c for new red wheat west, Manitoba wheat is easier, at 86c to 87c for No. 1 hard, and at 88c to 89c for No. 2 hard. At Port William, and 81c for old wheat is quoted at \$1.05 at Goderich, and new at 85c.
