FOR HOUSEKEEPERS.
There was a vast improvement in the attendance at the market here today. With the exception of hay, which was dull of sale, the market was exceedingly lively. Sales were quickly made, and by 11:30 o'clock nearly all of the offerings were disposed of at good prices.
Hay and Straw—Twenty-eight loads of hay on sale. Prices are a trifle lower at \$5 to \$6 per ton for best timothy, and \$5 to \$6 per ton for clover. Straw is becoming more plentiful. Prices are lower at \$5 to \$6 per ton. About 30 tons of baled straw has been disposed of at \$5 and \$5.50 per ton.
Butter and Eggs—Butter continues to be in good demand. The supply is light with prices firm, at 18c to 19c per lb for creamery, and 15c to 17c per lb for store. Eggs were in large supply, nearly every vehicle having them. The demand is good, and prices are firm at 13c to 14c by the crate and basket, and 12c to 15c per single dozen. Prices are expected to remain firm until Easter.
Apples—A dull sale of apples. Prices are too high for the majority of citizens. Prices are as quoted.
Vegetables and Roots—Potatoes were plentiful at 6c to 7c per bag; onions sell at \$1 per bu; green onions sell at 25c to 40c per dozen; rhubarb, 90c to \$1 per dozen; spinach, 60c to 75c per bu.
Poultry—Was in good demand, especially chickens, which were firm at 75c to 90c per pair for dressed chickens; 60c to 70c per pair for live; turkeys are firm, at 12c to 13c per lb.
Dressed Hogs—In good demand at \$5 per cwt.
Live Hogs—Mr. D. McIntyre will pay \$5.75 per cwt for live hogs on Monday.
Meats—Were plentiful. Some nice veal sold by the carcass as high as \$3 per cwt; about 50 hindquarters of pork at 80c per lb; forequarters at 80c per lb.
Maple syrup sells at \$1 per gallon.

AGRICULTURAL SEED TRADE.
London, March 21.—Messrs. John Shaw & Sons, seed merchants, of London, report a quiet business passing. The larger firms have already made their early purchases, while the general country seedsmen are only just beginning to operate. Meanwhile values all round exhibit great steadiness, and in view of the large receipts to be realized and the moderate state of stocks, excepting as regards red clover seed, which have to meet a most anxious and consumptive demand in which confidence shortly anticipated. Alsike, trefoil and white clover seed must be quoted at a low level, as the demand for grass is by no means any cheaper. The rye grass market continues dull and quiet. Mustard and rape seed show no change. Mustard seed is in moderate demand. Spring tares attract more attention on former terms; winter vetches being apparently scarce. The movement in canary seed continues erratic and puzzling; other descriptions of bird seed presenting no features of interest. Peas and haricots have been selling better.

LONDON WOOL SALES.

London, March 21.—The offerings at the wool auction sales today numbered 14,300 bales. Scores were in keen request for the continent. Cross-breds were bought chiefly by the home trade. Some light conditioned merinos and good medium cross-breds were taken by Americans. Following are the sales in detail: New South Wales, 3,100 bales; scored, 2 1/2 to 3 1/2; greasy, 3 1/2 to 1 1/2. Queensland, 1,300 bales; scored, 1 1/2 to 1 3/4; greasy, 1 1/2 to 1 3/4. Victoria, 1,600 bales; scored, 1 1/2 to 1 3/4; greasy, 1 1/2 to 1 3/4. Tasmania, 100 bales; greasy, 7 1/2 to 1 1/2. New Zealand, 6,400 bales; scored, 5 1/2 to 1 3/4; greasy, 5 1/2 to 1 3/4. Cape of Good Hope and Natal, 1,500 bales; scored, 7 1/2 to 1 3/4; greasy, 4 to 9 1/2.

CHICAGO, March 21.—Grains were nervous and erratic again today, and set of prices was not very high. The southwest was decidedly bearish in their influence over wheat, while a continued heavy export business in cash wheat tended to induce higher prices. Fluctuations were frequent and other grain acted sympathetically. At the close May wheat had last 4c. Local receipts of wheat were 21 cars. 1 of contract grade; 20 of cash. Total receipts, 22 cars, or a total for the three points of 25 cars, against 26 last week and 42 a year ago. Estimated receipts were 45,000 bu, compared to 71,000 bu last year. Seaboard

clearances in wheat and flour equaled 128,000 bu. Argentine shipments were 1,238,000 bu against 429,000 bu last week, and 1,912,000 bu a year ago. The seaboard reported 52 loads taken for export. Estimated receipts for tomorrow: Wheat, 20 cars; corn, 40 cars; oats, 155 cars; hogs, 25,000 head.
