TIME.—Probably A. D. 80. PLACE.—We do not know where the words of the first part of this lesson were spoken. The miracle was wrought at some point on the boundary line of the provinces of Samaria and Galilee. Jesus was going southeastward toward the Jordan, which he crossed probably not far from Bethabara. It is to be dated, therefore, in all probability, somewhat earlier than the Perean parables which we have recently
