



EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN CANADA AND DENMARK MODIFYING THE AGREEMENT OF 1949 CONCERNING AIR SERVICES

SIR,

I have the honour to inform you that the Scandinavian Airlines System is now in a position to inaugurate a service to Montreal and that a proposal for the modification of section 4 of the Annex to the Agreement between Denmark and Canada for Air Services between the two countries, signed at Ottawa on December 13, 1949,* has been made by the competent Danish aeronautical authorities under the terms of Article 7 of the Agreement to the competent Canadian aeronautical authorities. It is understood that the latter have now agreed to the proposed changes to the said Agreement and, accordingly, it would thus be in order to confirm the agreement between the aeronautical authorities of our respective countries by an exchange of notes.

Upon instructions from my Government I now have the honour to propose that section 4 of the Annex to the Agreement between Denmark and Canada for Air Services between the two countries, signed at Ottawa on December 13, 1949, be amended to read as follows:

"The route to be operated by the designated airline of Denmark shall be: Denmark via intermediate points to Montreal and to points in countries beyond—in both directions."

If the Canadian Government is prepared to accept this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your reply thereto shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments, which shall take effect on the date of your reply.

Accept, Sir, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
