

IV. Droits et taxes

Le matériel, les matériaux et autres biens introduits au Canada par ou pour les États-Unis en vue de l'exécution des présents accords, et le matériel, les matériaux et autres biens acquis au Canada par ou pour les États-Unis dans le même dessein seront exempts de droits de douane ainsi que des taxes fédérales d'accise et de vente.

V. Accords complémentaires

Il pourra être conclu par intervalles entre les autorités compétentes des deux Gouvernements des accords pratiques ou administratifs complémentaires, conformes à l'esprit du présent Mémoire d'accord.

I have the honour to refer to your Note No. 604 dated June 12, 1961, regarding the understandings reached between representatives of the Government of Canada and of the Government of the United States regarding the means for ensuring the most effective use of certain resources which each Government is prepared to make available pursuant to the objectives of the North Atlantic Treaty, concerning the independence of the Canada-United States Region of NATO, transmuting the Defence Production Sharing Program between our two Governments, and the provision of assistance to certain other NATO Governments. Your Excellency's Note is acceptable to the Government of Canada and it is agreed that your Note, the terms set out in the enclosed Memorandum of Understanding, and this reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments on this subject which shall enter into force on the date of this Note.

As adopted, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
