

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE  
GOVERNMENT OF THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE SUDAN  
FOR THE TRAINING IN CANADA OF PERSONNEL OF THE ARMED  
FORCES OF THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE SUDAN**

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Democratic Republic of the Sudan, hereinafter referred to as Canada and Sudan respectively,

CONSIDERING that Sudan has requested Canada to provide training in Canada for personnel of the armed forces of Sudan,

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

**ARTICLE I**

*Definitions*

In this Agreement:

- (a) "trainee" means a member of the armed forces of Sudan who has been authorized by his government to undergo training in Canada with the Canadian Forces and who has been accepted by Canada for training;
- (b) "training" means the military training prescribed by the Chief of the Defence Staff of the Canadian Forces.

**ARTICLE II**

*Training and Costs*

Subject to terms and conditions of this Agreement, Canada shall provide training in Canada for trainees in such numbers as may from time to time be agreed upon by the appropriate authorities of the Sudan and Canada.

**ARTICLE III**

Unless other arrangements are made for particular courses of training, costs shall be borne as follows:

- (a) Canada shall bear the costs of:
  - (i) the allowances mentioned in subparagraphs (b) (iii) and (iv) of Article IV of this Agreement,
  - (ii) tuition, clothing and equipment required for training, and all other training costs,
  - (iii) rations and quarters,
  - (iv) duty travel in connection with the training, and
