Mr. Kelleher said that in response to the tremendous interest shown in this market by the private sector, up to four additional trade representatives will be assigned to the Canadian Embassy in China. Two of those trade officers will specialize in regions of China outside Beijing. After being consulted, the provinces agreed with this project. They had in fact urged that trade representation in China be increased. In addition he indicated that over the next few months further initiatives would be announced to expand our trade relations with China.
