I have a list here, if he is interested in it, of the areas where increases have been effected since June 15, the period of time to which he has referred in his notice. I am glad to tell him that the majority of these increases are automatic

and result from increases in municipal taxes.

In view of the detail involved as to places, amounts and the reasons in each case, I wonder whether he would agree to my tabling this list.
