

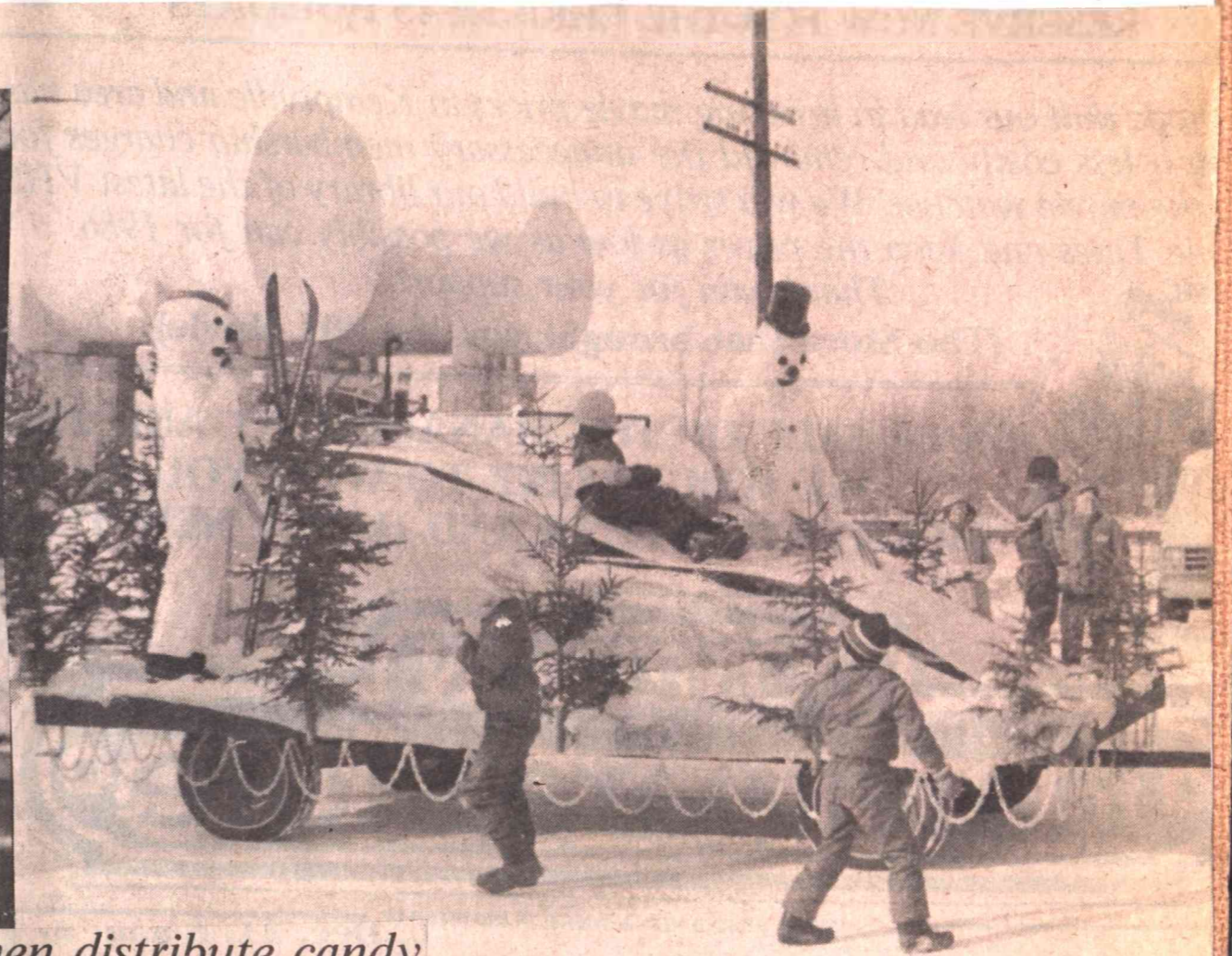
Parade winds
