Dear Mr. Ward:

The invoices covering expenditures by the Institute of Parasitology, which have been audited by the Auditor General of Canada, have just been returned to us. I enclose, for your information, a copy of a letter which I have written to the Empire Marketing Board in this connection requesting a further payment from them.

You will note that in auditing, certain small errors were discovered which reduced the total credit of \$14,920.08 to \$14,918.75. I am asking Mr. Shaver, our Accountant, to send you a detailed explanation of this difference of \$1.33, in order that your records may be complete.

I am enclosing Research Council cheque made out in favour of Macdonald College for the sum of \$2,459.38, this being the balance due from the National Research Council in connection with expenditures incurred during the fiscal year just closed on March 31 last. This will leave you with an advance of \$5,000.00 from the National Research Council to be applied on expenditures incurred during the fiscal year which began on April 1 last.

May I take this opportunity of congratulating you on the very great care and trouble which you and your staff obviously took in preparing the invoices covering last year's operations. Our Accountant after making his pre-audit prior to submitting them to the Auditor General remarked to me that they were one of the best set of invoices which he has ever received, and it gives me very great pleasure to pass his comment on to you and your staff, and to assure
