Chines-chamúsi, chin-chamús, *v. pass.* (5) I am being consumed by fire. 'Chamús,' Destroyed by fire, burned down.

Ies-chamúsem, chamúsen, chamúsent, (8) I destroy it by fire. 'Zu iszchamús,' What I have destroyed by fire.

" chamúltém, chamúltén, chamúlt, *v. rel.* (16) I burn down his, *v. g.* candle. 'La iszchamúlt,' What has been consumed to me by fire.

Chines-chamspuúsi, or, chines-champspuúsi, chin-chamspuús, chamspuúsis, *v. intr.* (5) My heart is burned, consumed, on account of something not specified. ~~Ch~~ Ch

Ies-chamspuúsem, or, ies-champspuúsem, chamspuústen, chamspuúsku, *v. act. real.* (8) I make his heart consume, as by fire, on account of something.

Ies-chamspuúsem, chamspuúsemen, chamspuúsement, *v. act. real.* (9) I feel my heart burning, consuming on it, *v. g.* 'Chamspuúsemenis tu szechamen,' *Zelus templi consumpsit eum.*

" chamspuúsmitem, chamspuúsmiten, chamspuúsmít, *v. rel.* (16) My heart is consumed for his.....

Chines-champspuúsemísti, champspuúsemíst, champspuúsemístsh, *v. refl.* I am consuming my heart, (repining) on myself.

Ies-champspuúsemístém, champspuúsemístemen, champspuúsementement, (9) I worry myself to death for it.

Chines-champspuúsenzúti, champspuúsenzút, champspuúsenzútsh, *v. refl.* (5) I worry myself to death.

Ies-champspuúsenzútem, champspuúsenzútemen, *v. act. instr.* (9) I worry myself to death on account of him.

Chines-agám, chin-agém, agéish, *v. act. indef.* (7) I tie, bind, stake a hide, *v. g.* to stretch it on the ground and dress it.

Ies-agém, agantén, agént, *contin.* esagesku, *v. act. real.* (10) I tie, stake that hide for drying it; *partic.* szaág, 'A kknepszaág?' Did you stretch out any hide to dry?

Aganzúten, *s.* Stretcher of hides, etc.

Ies-agugém, *red.*

" agaminem, agamín, agamínt, *v. act. instr.* (11) I use it to stretch hides, etc.

Agamín, *s.* What one uses to stretch. Agamínten, *id.* but relating to the thing stretched, not to the person. 'In-aga-
