furnish their accounts annually in December, which accounts shall be examined and reported upon by a Committee of three Members, to be nominated on the regular night in December; and it shall be the duty of the Committee to see that the accounts are correctly and properly adjusted, and that no accounts are paid by the Treasurer, unless duly authorised by the Lodge, and signed by the Master, in order that a final and proper adjustment of the year's transactions may be made previously to the new Master being installed in the Chair.

## LODGE CLOTHING.

I

Every Member of this Lodge shall provide himself with proper Masonic Clothing, agreeably to the directions contained in the Book of Constitutions, and inserted at the end of these Bye Laws; and no Brother or visitor shall, on any pretence, be admitted into the Lodge without his proper Clothing.

## LODGE SEAL

ī.

The Seal of this Lodge shall be in the custody of the Master, and shall be affixed to all documents proper to be issued; and in case the impression of
