THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL Z¹⁴.

An Act for the relief of Kathleen Florence Pippy Hayward.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Kathleen Florence Pippy Hayward, residing at the town of Gander, in the province of Newfoundland, wife of Ellis Raymond Hayward, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the city of St. John's, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married 5 on the fourteenth day of October, A.D. 1933, at Brigus, in the said province, she then being Kathleen Florence Pippy, a spinster; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, because of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have 10 been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved. 1. The said marriage between Kathleen Florence Pippy 15 and Ellis Raymond Hayward, her husband, is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Right to marry again. 2. The said Kathleen Florence Pippy may at any time hereafter marry any man whom she might lawfully marry 20 if the said marriage with the said Ellis Raymond Hayward had not been solemnized.
