For the information of Christians generally, it may be briefly stated that this Institution, now in full operation, owes its origin to the liberality of a Christian gentleman, a resident of Toronto, who has invested a portion of his means in the enterprise, as a freewill offering to the Lord, with the view of scattering broadcast over our land Tracts, Books, &c., &c., which unfold the exalted privileges of believers, and treat of the "Life of Faith" or Trust, and of the Power and Peace of Holiness.

Special notice is called to the fact that this is no denominational institution. It is neither connected with, nor under the patronage of any particular church. All the publications it issues will be strictly evangelical, and will meet the wants of all Christians. Largely the Books, Tracts, &c., &c., will be those published by the Willard Tract Repository of Boston, under the care of the well known Dr. Cullis.

But this will not, by any means, limit the supply. The stock will be enriched by publications on Scriptural Holiness, and other religious and Gospel literature, from whatever source they can be obtained, (including books, tracts, &c., published by ourselves), and that may be approved of by the Committee.
