## QUALIFICATION OF IMMIGRANTS FOR COVERAGE UNDER MEDICARE AND HOSPITAL INSURANCE

## Question No. 2,534—Mr. Caccia:

Is there a waiting period in each province for a landed immigrant before he/she qualifies for coverage under medicare and hospital insurance and, if so, what is the period in each case?

**Hon. Marc Lalonde (Minister of National Health and Welfare):** All provinces, except British Columbia, provide first day coverage to immigrants who are bona fide residents. In British Columbia, new residents can obtain coverage from the first day of the third month from the date of assuming residence in the province. A commercial plan offers temporary coverage for landed immigrants residing in British Columbia until they become eligible for coverage under the British Columbia public plans. In the case of most plans, eligibility for coverage is contingent upon registration, and payment of any required premium, within the appropriate grace period.
