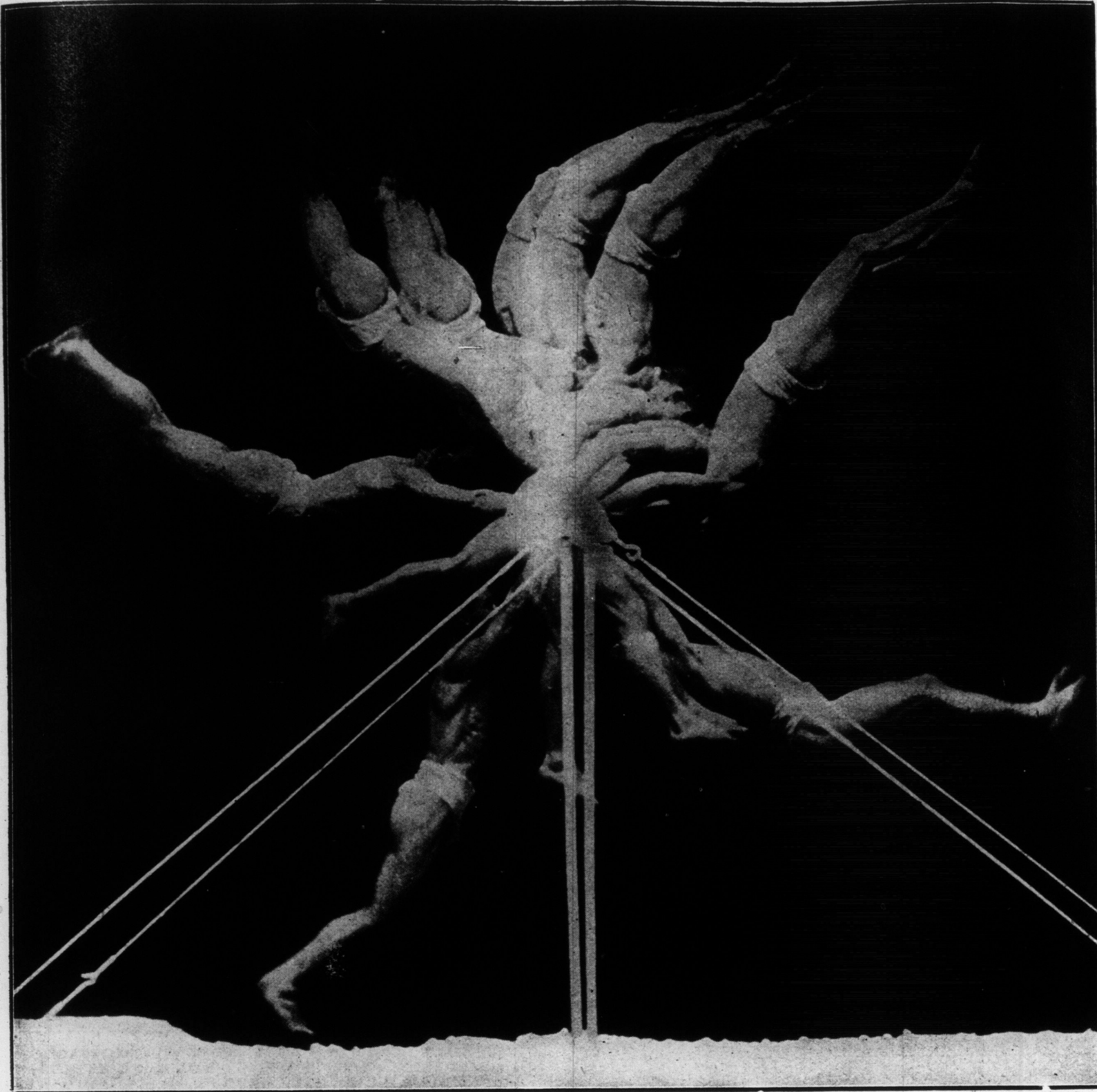


PICTURED NEWS FROM MANY PARTS--PHOTOGRAPHY AND ATHLETICS

The exposures are made at a comparatively slow rate, the camera being snapped open and shut at given intervals. A moving-picture camera, the nearest approach to this method, takes each movement on a separate negative.



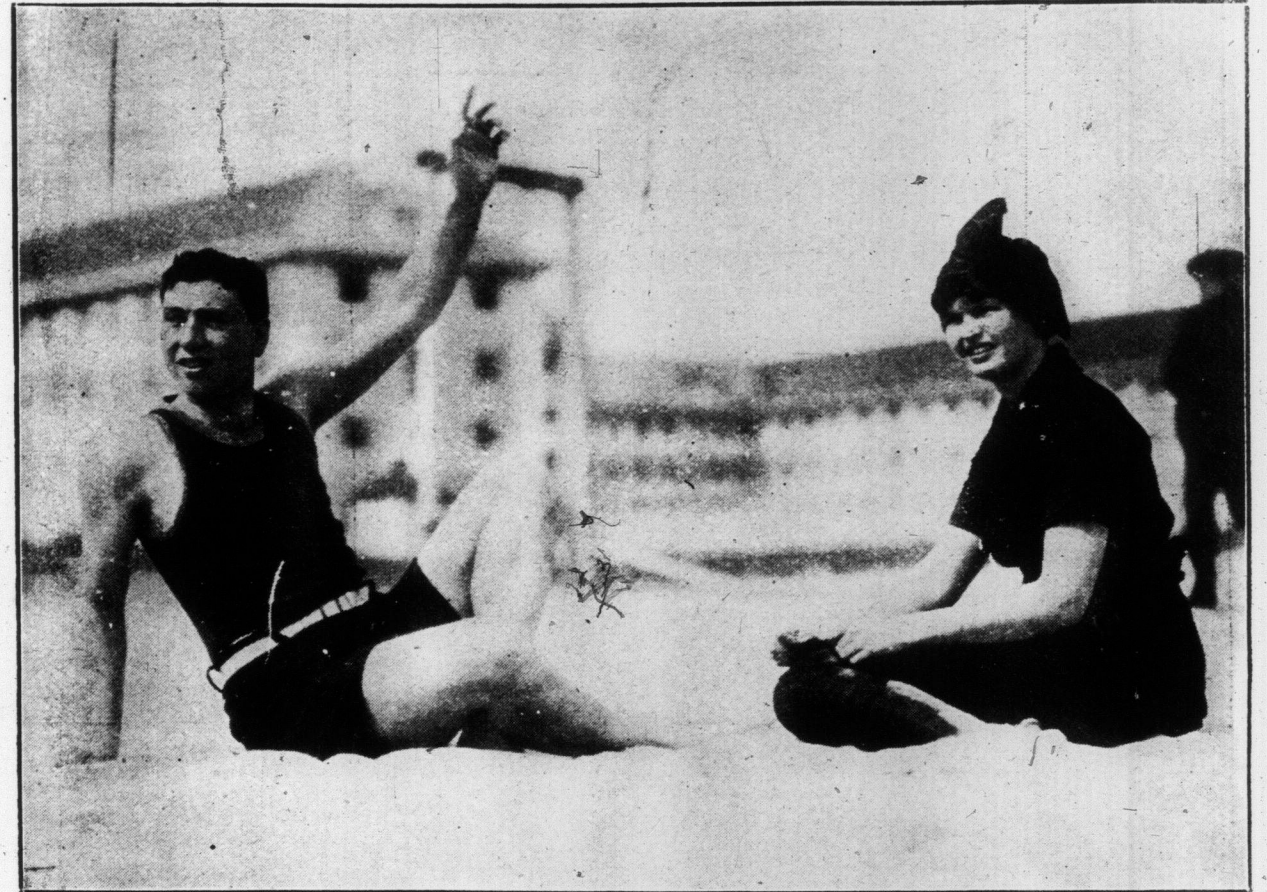

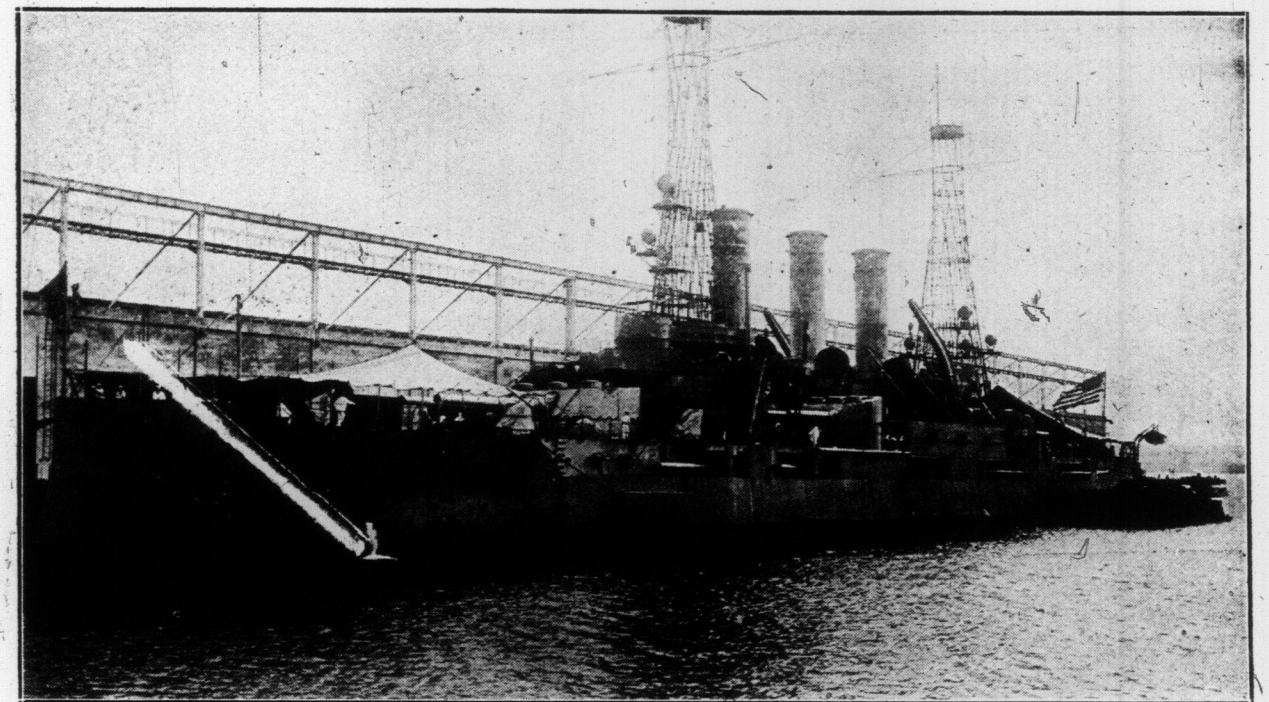

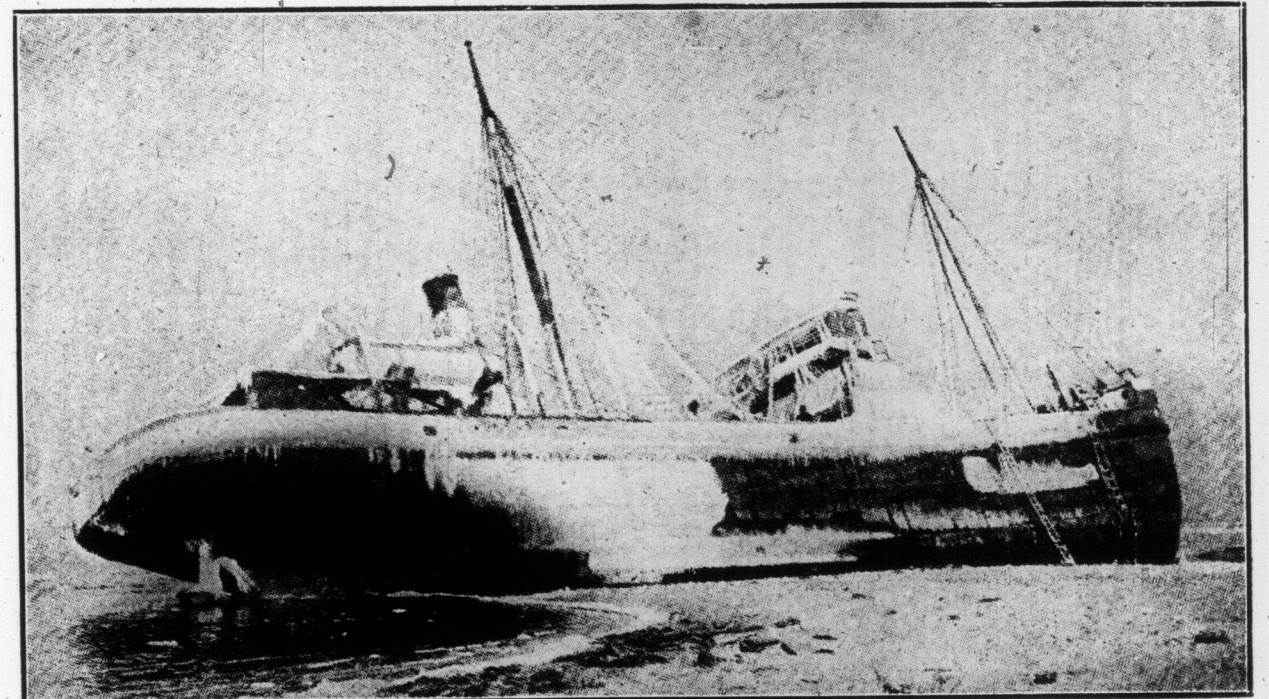

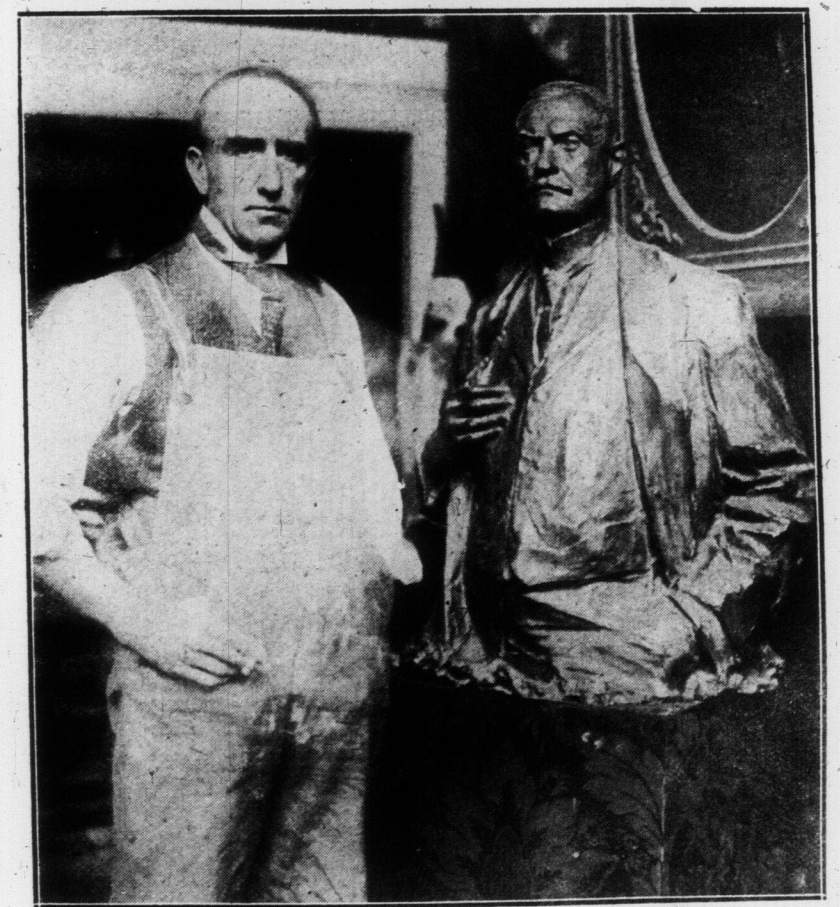
