Kiev, Russia, May 13—The expulsion of Jews residing illegally in Kiev will be referred today. In some instances a delay has been granted to permit a settlement of their affairs, but all of those marked for expulsion must leave the city before June 14.

The order of expulsion was issued as a result of an agitation which began in the Duma and originally provided that the expulsion should take place on April 28 last. Subsequently the order was suspended by Premier Stolypin to permit a further examination of Jewish claims of residence. The order applied to other cities and towns where Jews are residing without the pale and local complisations.
