


WELSH EISTEDDFOD AT CARNAVON

REPORT SAYS GREAT BALLOON HAS BLOWN UP

London, Aug. 24.—The giant airship ZR-2, purchased by the U. S. from Great Britain, exploded over the city of London today, according to reports received here, shortly after one o'clock this afternoon.

T. AND L. CONGRESS

Winnipeg, Aug. 24.—The administration of the Trades and Labor Congress of Canada was a decisive victory in a vote taken yesterday after three hours of debate on the matter of expenses incurred by J. C. Walters in a trip to Europe to the labor peace conference. The bill amounted to \$1,217, and Tom Moore, the president, warned Walters before he left that his bill would not be paid as he was not the duly appointed representative. The vote was about two to one against the bill.

The report of Secretary P. M. Draper, and labor congress, recorded total expenditures of \$4,787, leaving a balance of \$1,663. Of the money spent, \$1,181 went into the purchase of remodeling of headquarters in Ottawa.

Mr. Draper reported that the congress represented 176,778 paid members, and there were many more because memberships had not been kept up because they were out of work, so that he thought 225,000 workers were spoken for by the congress. These were in 2,000 local unions.

Senator G. D. Roberts, minister of labor, in a statement yesterday, refuted charges made against him in the Monday session of the trades and labor congress. The department of labor was charged with unfairly reducing the wages of the men working on the Welland canal. The senator has sent a letter to President Tom Moore denying the truth of the allegations made by the opening of the congress.

IN WALL STREET.
New York, Aug. 24.—August Stock continued to lose ground at the listless opening of today's session. New low records for the year were made by some of the prominent issues, notably Mercantile Marine, preferred, American International, Pullman, Anaconda Copper and International Paper, at initial prices running from large fractions to one point. Crude Oil, American Oil, and Cuba Cane Sugar and Great Northern also reacted. Union Pacific was the only stock to display strength, gaining one point on yesterday's favorable statement of earnings.

Noon Report.
New York, Aug. 24.—During the further selling of the morning, many low priced and obscure stocks broke into new low ground. These included Pierce Arrow, Common and Preferred, Columbia Gramophone common and preferred, Crucible Steel, Maniti Sugar, United Drug and Virginia Carolina Chemical, preferred, lost 11-12 to almost five points. Oils, especially the foreign group and the better grade of equipment and motors were strong. A seven point break in Soa, a Canadian Pacific subsidiary on a single sale was the only striking feature among the rail.

Money conditions were unchanged, call loans opening on the exchange at 5-12 per cent, with free offerings at five per cent, elsewhere.

USE OUR OWN COAL.
Ottawa, Aug. 24.—(Canadian Press)—Canadian coal for Canadian heating, is the slogan being followed by the Purchasing Commission of Canada, in securing fuel supplies for government buildings for the coming winter, according to a statement made here today by the commission.

MONTREAL STOCK EXCHANGE.
Montreal, Aug. 24.—The local stock exchange was slightly more active at the opening today, the feature of the first hour being a new low for Laurentide, this issue selling at 64 on the first board lot transaction, off a half point from last night's close, and almost immediately strengthening to 64 1/8. Smelters was up a quarter point at 15. Promont sold at an advance of a quarter point to 282 1/4. Breweries and Bell Telephone were unchanged.
