which the two premiers, according to best information, failed to agree at the Hythe conference of Saturday.

Reparations. Both premiers and M. Francos-Marsal, however, expressed upon their arrival perfect satisfaction with the results of the Hythe conference, contrasting general rumors. They said a complete accord between France and Great Britain had been reached at Hythe as to reparations and disarmament. They added that France has every reason to be satisfied.

London, June 21—Referring to the discussion of German reparations between the two premiers, the London Times says the basis accepted by the former Hythe conference regarding the inter-dependence of the payment of German reparations and the reimbursement of Allied debts could not be maintained owing to the opposition of the United States to accept it. It is said that British financial representatives declared themselves unable to agree to the former plan, inasmuch as Great Britain will have to bear the weight of her debt to the United States.

On the other hand, it was agreed, that Germany should be called upon to pay reparations in the form of annuities, which would be extendible in accordance to Germany's capacity to pay.

Hythe, England, June 21—(Associated Press)—While the question of German reparations was the ostensible reason for the convening of the Hythe conference with the French and British premiers, the Associated Press is authoritatively informed that the Turkish situation thrust itself into the forefront of their discussions yesterday.

London, June 21—(Associated Press)—Serious developments in the Near East seem to be the occasion of the hurried convening of the Hythe conference with the Greek Premier Venizelos, according to some of the London and Paris papers. It is asserted that the British Cabinet has accepted the offers of M. Venizelos of the Greek army to assist the British troops against Mustafa Kemal's Nationalist forces, and it is suggested that the Hythe conference was for the purpose of arranging details of combined operations.

The news from Malta of the concentration of a powerful British fleet in these waters and the despatch of fresh reinforcements to Constantinople appears to bear out these statements.

The only clause involved in execution of the treaty of Versailles on which all the Allies came to conference in perfect agreement is that relative to the disarmament of Germany.

Premier Venizelos will formally offer, in the name of Greece, to take the mandate for Armenia, and he will participate largely in all other discussions of Turkish questions.

Count Carlo Sforza, Italian foreign minister, will ask on behalf of Italy for twenty per cent of the reparations to be paid by Germany.

At the luncheon served immediately after the arrival of Lloyd George and Millerand the programme for this afternoon was decided upon. It is understood it was agreed that the first session to be discussed would be reparations on
