One jobber in woollens was reported to have sold a grade of cloth at \$10.50, for which the mill charge was not in excess of \$8.88, subject to discount. A custom shirt-maker of New York was willing to part with some of his shirtings at \$1.50 a yard, which sold at 57½ cents at the mill agency from which they were bought. A manufacturer of children's ready-to-wear cotton goods sold merchandise to a retailer at \$22.50 a dozen, and they were passed out over the counter "at cut prices" for \$3.50 each. A large New York retailer "reduced" prices on dress ginghams to 55 cents a yard, but jobbing houses in that city have never received more than 34 cents for the material in question at any time, and the agent's price was 3 cents, subject to a 10 and 2½ per cent discount.
