Toronto, Ont., Nov. 3.—The Canadian Northern railway report issued today, shows a net surplus of \$824,227 for the year ended June 30 last. The gross earnings were \$16,360,712; net earnings, \$4,909,356. The gross earnings show increase of 18.27 per cent, and net earnings 14.87 per cent. During the year more than 400 miles of new line were constructed. The total mileage is 3,721.

SHANGHAI NOW IN REVOLUTION GRIP Shanghai, Nov. 2.—The arsenal and the native city of Shanghai were taken over by the revolutionists late this afternoon. No resistance was offered by the authorities or such of the public as remains loyal. As the rebel flag went up over one building after another the arsenal, the Tao Tai, realizing the inevitable, caused notice to be posted stating that the native city might be taken over by the revolutionists tonight and expressing the hope that the public would not be thrown into a panic, and that the shops selling food should not be closed, except at the usual hour.
