KING EDWARD MAKES A FAVORABLE IMPRESSION

BERLIN, Feb. 12. — King Edward took a long automobile ride this morning through the Grunewald with Prince Henry of Prussia, after which he had luncheon with the Emperor. The King and Queen Alexandra, will leave here for London at 5 o'clock this afternoon.

The streets of Berlin are still gaily decorated with flags and the crowds continue to show much interest in the British ruler. Whenever he rides out the streets are lined with people anxious to see him. The impression made by the King on the German people has been very favorable, and his visit to the town hall of this city two days ago is regarded as a high compliment to the German burgher classes as well as a tribute to the merchants and financiers of the country, who are in reality the makers of modern Germany.

While the newspapers continue to assert that there is little expectation of tangible and positive results from the royal visit they express the belief that the coming of the king will promote a good understanding between the two countries. The statement made yesterday that King Edward has found it necessary to consult with a German physician because of a cold is today given semi-official denial.

NEW HYDRANTS FOR KING ST.

Safety Board So
Decide

DELEGATIONS HEARD

Ladies Who Want Patrol
Wagon Referred to Chief
Clark

At a special meeting of the Board of Public Safety held last night it was decided to recommend to the council that the present King street hydrants be taken up and that those of another type be placed in their stead. The German street hydrants were recommended to be connected with the twelve main.

A delegation from the Women's Council asked that a patrol wagon be put in operation and that a motor be installed at the police station. The delegation was referred to the chief of police.

A delegation from the West End Every Day Club of Carleton the use of the large lower room of the City Hall at a nominal rental. This request was accepted, the amount of rent to be paid being fixed at \$1 per year.

The meeting was called to order at eight o'clock by Chairman Vanwart. There were present with the director Ald. Sprout, Holder, McGowan, Ekins, Baskin and Scully. Owing to the absence of the common clerk the minutes were recorded by Chief Kerr.

The delegation from the Women's Council consisted of Mrs. McEllan, Mrs. Ballock and Mrs. Chisholm. Mrs. McEllan made a strong plea for the inauguration of the reforms recommended by the council. She stated that last spring a petition had been placed before the board and she asked what had become of it. She thought that a patrol wagon could be operated with little additional expense to the taxpayers, and she insisted that not a single citizen would disapprove of the action of the board in the event of the request being granted. Mrs. McEllan held that the spectacle of half-naked men and women being driven on slovens through the streets of the city should not have existed for a moment.

Mr. Anderson is extremely well informed in all matters of forestry and conversant with the district in land, including the timber as acquired by the International Railway, in a strip was not worth \$10. On motion of Ald. Sprout the plans for the shelving of the vaults at City Hall were approved and the work ordered to be prosecuted with at a cost not to exceed \$500.

Rev. Mr. Robinson eloquently pleaded for the co-operation of the board in the work of ministering to the men who were down and out. He thought that the institution of an Every Day Club in Carleton would do much to the city and as a small matter for the board to take up.

Mr. Halsey and Chas. G. Brown followed Mr. Robinson in urging that the city allow the club the use of the large lower room of the City Hall.

A communication was read from the Carleton Cornet Band asking for the rent of the same room at a rental of \$100 per annum. Ald. Scully thought that the city should not be asked to pay remuneration in the event of the room being leased. Director Wisely stated that the room was not yet rented for the room they now occupied.

Ald. Scully thought that the director was responsible for this, and asked that the matter be investigated.

On motion of Ald. Baskin the club was allowed the use of the room for one year at a rental of one dollar per annum. Ald. Scully and McGowan dissented.

The report of the chiefs of the fire and police departments were not read, owing to the lateness of the hour, but at the instance of Chief Kerr it was decided to recommend the immediate substitution of the King street hydrants for those of another type by connecting with the twelve inch main of the hydrants on German street.

The meeting then adjourned.
