Mr. *Laurier* moved, in amendment, seconded by Mr. *Vail*, That all the words after " be " to the end of the Question, be left out, and the words " re-committed to a Committee of the Whole House, with power to amend the same by providing that the route for the line of Railway connecting *Montreal* with the Harbours of *St. John* and *Halifax*, for which a subsidy of \$170,000 a year, for fifteen years, is provided, shall be subject to the approval of Parliament," inserted instead thereof ;
