94. All contracts and all legal proceedings by, with, or concerning Contracts to the Association, shall be made and had with the Board of Agriculture, be made with so constituted as such Council, in its corporate capacity, and no other Agriculture. contracts, agreements, actions or proceedings shall bind or affect the 5 Association.

TITLE OF THIS ACT.

95. This Act shall be known as and may be called "The Act for the encouragement of Agriculture, Arts and Manufactures.".

REPEALING CLAUSE.

10 96. Chapter thirty-two of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, Title of this intituled: An Act respecting the Bureau of Agriculture and Agricul-Act. tural Societies, is hereby repealed.
