110. All assets connected with such portions of the public Assets condebt of each Province as are assumed by that Province shall nected with Provincial belong to that Province.

- 111. Canada shall be liable for the debts and liabilities of Qanada to be liable to Proeach Province existing at the Union. vincial debts.
- 112. Ontario and Quebec conjointly shall be liable to Debts of Canada for the amount (if any) by which the debt of the Ontario and Province of Canada avocada at the Union sixty the Union si Province of Canada exceeds at the Union sixty-two millions five hundred thousand dollars, and shall be charged with interest at the rate of five per cent. per annum thereon.

- 113. The assets enumerated in the fourth schedule to this Assets of Act belonging at the Union to the Province of Canada shall Ontario and Quebec. be the property of Ontario and Quebec conjointly.
- 114. Nova Scotia shall be liable to Canada for the amount Debt of (if any) by which its public debt exceeds at the Union eight Nova Scotia. million dollars, and shall be charged with interest at the rate of five per centum per annum thereon.
- 115. New Brunswick shall be liable to Canada for the nebt of New amount (if any) by which its public debt exceeds at the Brunswick. Union seven million dollars, and shall be charged with interest at the rate of five per centum per annum thereon.
- #F116. In case the public debts of Nova Scotia and New Payment of Brunswick do not at the Union amount to eight million and interest to Nova Scotia seven million dollars respectively, they shall respectively and New receive by half-yearly payments in advance from the Govern-Brunswick. ment of Canada interest at five per centum per annum on the difference between the actual amounts of their respective debts and such stipulated amounts.

117. The several Provinces shall retain all their respect-Provincial tive public property not otherwise disposed of in this Act, public property. subject to the right of Canada to assume any land or public property required for fortifications or for the defence of the country.

118. The following sums shall be paid yearly by Canada Grants to to the several Provinces for the support of their Govern-Provinces. ments and Legislatures: -
