Her debut on the television screen was on a locally televised fashion show. Subsequently, over a cup of coffee with the producer, the food show idea was thought up.

Because of genuine interest and concern with everyone and everything she meets, Inge has become fully immersed in many delightful and delectable subjects through the show.
