

On May 11, 1891, ~~similar~~ bill to strike out
the words "unduly" and "unreasonably"
from the statute were introduced in the
Senate by Hon. Mr. McCallum and in the House
of Commons by Mr. H. Clark Wallace. The
Senate bill received all three readings, but
the measure which was introduced by Mr.
Wallace in the Lower House did not go
beyond second reading at that session.

The latter (that is the bill for the revision of the
Criminal Code) did not, however, become
law at that session.

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
