A BILL

FOR

- 1 AN ACT TO REGULATE AND LIMIT THE HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT
- 2 IN ALL CEMENT WORKS, ROLLING MILLS, ROD MILLS, AND
- 3 BLAST FURNACES; TO DECLARE CERTAIN EMPLOYMENTS IN-
- 4 JURIOUS TO HEALTH AND DANGEROUS TO LIFE AND LIMB;
- 5 TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PRO-
- 6 VISIONS OF THIS ACT.
- 7 Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
- 8 Section 1. Employment in all cement works, rolling mills, rod mills, and
- 9 blast furnaces is hereby declared to be injurious to health and dangerous to
- 10 life and limb.
- 31 Section 2. That the period of employment of men working in all cement
- 12 works, rolling mills, rod mills, and blast furnaces shall not exceed eight (8)
- 13 hours within any twenty-four (24) hours except in cases of emergency where
- 14 life or property is in imminent danger.
- 15 Section 3. Any person, persons, body corporate, general manager or em-
- 16 ployer who shall violate or cause to be violated any of the provisions of this
- 17 act, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof
- 18 shall be punished by a fine of not less than two hundred and fifty dollars

(\$250) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500), or by imprisonment in the

- 20 county jail not less than ninety days (90) nor more than six months (6),
- 21 or by both such fine and imprisonment. Every day's violation of the pro-
- 22 visions of this act shall constitute a separate offense.
- 23 Section 4. The General Assembly hereby finds, determines and declares
